

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS:

Applicants who meet the following criteria are eligible to use eCRBA:

- The child born abroad must be under the age of 18.
- At least one of the child's parents must have been a U.S. citizen or U.S. non-citizen national at the time of the child's birth.
- The biological parents of the child, the child's legal guardian, or the child him/herself, are/is completing the application.
- Applicant can pay online via credit card or an Automated Clearing House (ACH) transaction from an American bank account.
- Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART) was not used.
- Applicant is applying in the Tokyo consular district where the child was born.

REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS:

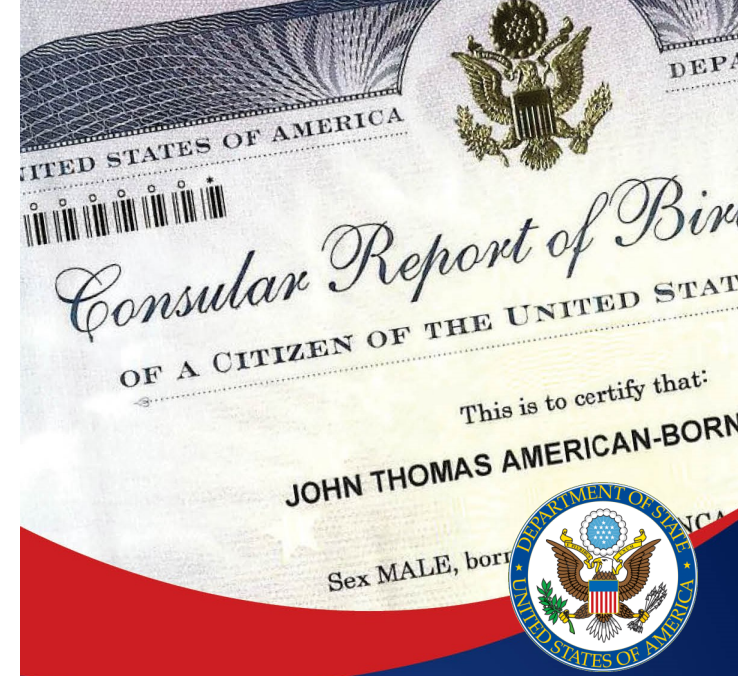
You must provide supporting documents to show:

- Record of the child's birth.
- Parents' citizenship.
- Parents' identification.
- Evidence of parents' marriages and/or termination of marriages by death or divorce.
- Evidence of legal relationship and financial support (only in certain cases).
- Residence and physical presence in the United States prior to the child's birth.

APPLYING ONLINE FOR A CONSULAR REPORT OF BIRTH ABROAD

If you are applying for a Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA) for your child, you have the option to complete the application process online. eCRBA is a secure and easy web solution, which enables you to fill out the required forms, attach all necessary documents, pay fees, and schedule your appointment.

Scan and save your documents as PDF files on your computer

Public facilities such as libraries, internet cafes, and universities often have scanners and computers that you can use. Just make sure you delete your files from any public computers that you use.

Register for an account at MyTravel.gov and create an eCRBA application

eCRBA will guide you through the online application process. You will enter the same information as in a paper CRBA application and then upload all required documents.

3



Pay the eCRBA fee and schedule your interview

After you fill out all required information and upload all evidence, you will be prompted to pay the CRBA fee online using a credit card or a U.S. bank account. Once payment is complete, you will schedule an interview at the U.S. Embassy Tokyo.

You must bring your child and originals of all supporting documents to your interview at the U.S. Embassy Tokyo. During the interview, a consular officer will ask you questions to verify the information you provided online, review the original documents, and decide whether to approve the application.
